Black Disruptors Data Analytics

Overview

You will follow the Black Disruptors Data Analytics course, which includes Data Design, visualisation and handling, Project Management and Microsoft Azure AI.

You will also get a chance to take part projects to put your skills to the test.

This skills bootcamp also gives you career support to prepare you for interviews and a tech career, after the course, in a number of junior tech and security roles.

What will I learn on this Skills Bootcamp?

You will learn the fundamentals of using Tableau for data visualisation and interpretation, Data tools and project planning.

You will also get a chance to use the skills you learn in practical sessions and a final week commercial project.

We will also prepare you and support you to get a new role in the tech industry, through supporting your personal development. You will be able to achieve qualifications in the following: Microsoft Azure AI fundamentals and Microsoft Azure AI Engineer Associate Qualification, once you sit and pass the final exam.

Modules covered

- Career preparation
- Data Handling and Decision-Making using Data tools
- Introduction to Data Design,
- Data Visualisation and Interpretation using Tableau
- Microsoft Azure AI Training
- Project Management Techniques and Project planning

How is the Skills Bootcamp delivered?

This skills bootcamp is a part time 16-week programme, with 15 weeks of course content. This includes two evenings a week of guided learning, plus self-learning, followed by one week of a project. This skills bootcamp is delivered fully remote, in the evenings.

Am I eligible to take part?

The course is fully funded and open to residents of the North West aged 19 or over, who are either in-work, looking for work, or have been unemployed for 12 months or less.

In addition to this, you must be a black female as Black Coders courses are all run with the purpose of getting more black women into technology careers.

I've had a long-term interest in tech but did not know how I would be able to pursue it alongside a full-time non-STEM degree.

When I saw the opportunity, I just couldn't let it pass me by (although I was worried, I would not be qualified). The two key aspects of the bootcamps provided by Niyo Network that appealed to me in particular were: 1) the breadth of knowledge and practical skills on offer and 2) the focus on employability and job-readiness.

The latter is of particular importance given I am a final year university student, and particularly keen on expanding my employment prospects. Coming from a non-STEM background, at times it has been somewhat difficult to get my head around the more intricate topics. Additionally, doing the Bootcamp alongside full-time University study can be difficult, particularly given that the sessions can be after a full day of work.
